GOVERNMENT RISK MANAGEMENT POLICY STATEMENT

The ACT Government has adopted the following policy on risk management:

The Government is committed to managing risk to meet its fiscal, environmental and social responsibilities.

A whole of Government framework for Enterprise-wide Risk Management will ensure that risk is a part of all program delivery.

Implementation of the framework demonstrates to constituents that risk has been assessed and managed in accordance with stakeholder expectations.

Chief Executives are responsible for developing risk management strategies and practices within their agencies and for ensuring that these strategies are communicated to and practised by all employees.

The implementation process will be based on the Australia and New Zealand Risk Management Standard (AS/NZS 4360:1999), which defines risk and provides guidelines on policies, strategies and procedures to manage it.

The ACT Insurance Authority (ACTIA) is responsible under its Act for providing advice to the Government on issues relating to the managing risks. ACTIA will assist agencies to implement the risk management policy and procedures across the whole Government.
