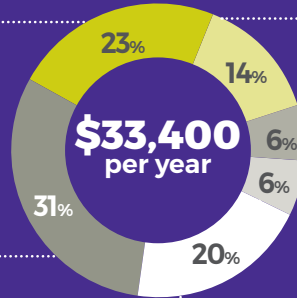

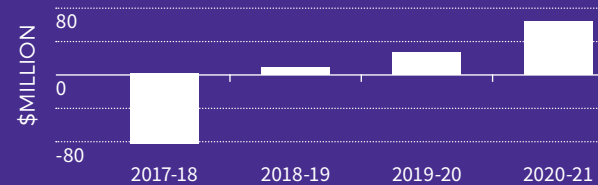

- > \$4.5 million to **fix local roads**
- > Tuggeranong to benefit from **more firefighters** across Canberra
- > **Extending the Blue Rapid** link from Kippax to Lanyon Market Place
- > **Free off-peak bus travel** for seniors and concession card holders
- > **Improving Tharwa Village firefighting** water supply



BETTER SCHOOLS FOR OUR KIDS

- > \$85 million for **school classroom and facilities upgrades** including at Lake Tuggeranong College
- > **Safer walking and cycling** around our schools, with new school crossing supervisors and better road signage
- > **Devices for students** to support technology-enabled learning
- > **Supporting students with a disability** to ensure they can access their local public schools



BUILDING A BETTER CITY

- > **Improving Tuggeranong Town Centre and Kambah Village** with new outdoor furniture and landscaping
- > Better facilities at the **Tuggeranong Arts Centre**
- > **Upgrading footpaths** and completing missing links in local cycle paths
- > Early planning for **upgrades to the Monaro Highway** between Johnson Drive and Canberra Avenue
